



## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Zika virus is an enveloped virus in the Flaviviridae family. It is endemic in South-East Asia, but only rarely causes disorders. Individual imported infections were found in tourists in Japan, Canada and Germany. The majority of cases are mild. Most frequent symptoms include fever, maculopapular exanthema, conjunctivitis, joint and headache, and distal oedema. In rare cases, complications with neurological symptoms or autoimmune reactions may occur. Zika virus is mainly transmitted by infected mosquitoes of the Aedes genus.


Herewith we confirm that all our disinfectants are virucidal against enveloped viruses and therefore effective against Zika viruses.
